



# Spectator Information

## Do's and Don'ts

---

Welcome Texas Mile Spectators,

By entering Victoria Regional Airport, I demonstrate my acknowledgement that I have read the spectator instructions. I will abide by each rule, verbal and written. I understand that part of the staff is the Christian Motorcycle Association & Local Law Enforcement who are serving as paddock & boundary marshals.

1. **Event Wristband:** \$25 per person, ages 13 and up. Children 12 and under are free. Wristbands are good for all 3 days with in and out privileges.  
**Wrist Bands:** You must wear your wrist band on your left or right wrist. Your wristband is good for all three days, so make sure you keep it on if you plan to return to the track all three days otherwise you will be required to pay the entry fee again.
2. **Parking:** Please follow the directions given by staff. Cars and motorcycles can park in the designated areas. Please do not block-in cars, motorcycles or trailers. We will be monitoring the congestion in the paddock area.
3. **NO PARKING AREAS/ OFF LIMITS AREAS.** Please abide by all NO PARKING AND DO NOT ENTER signs.
4. **Driving on the paved paddock road** is not allowed for spectators. You cannot use your motorcycle or car to "cruise" the paddock. This is for participants traveling to & from pits. (You can use a golf cart to cruise the paddock; we have onsite rentals or you can bring your own)
5. **Walking in the paddock:** Only walk on the pit side. Do not walk on the paddock road.
6. **Viewing areas:** You can find a spot on the pit side of the paddock to set-up chairs or in designated Spectator Viewing areas. In paddock areas, please do not block participants or their vehicles.
7. **Restricted Areas:** Airport traffic areas. The large center grass area that separates the paddock from the course. Hot staging area. The course. Beyond the cones in the paddock. In or around the buildings. All other areas not being used by the event.
8. **Concessions:** Food and drink vendors will be on-site.
9. **Do not bring in** Bar-B-Q pits. No open flames or charcoal. Propane only.
10. **NO GLASS BOTTLES/CONTAINERS**
11. **NO ALCOHOL IN GRID AND TECH AREA.**
12. Please follow **paddock speed – 5 MPH.**
13. **Children must be with an adult at ALL TIMES. Children are not allowed to operate ANY TYPE of motorized vehicle at ANY TIME. Children cannot operate bikes, scooters, bicycles, skate boards, roller skates or wear Heely skate shoes.**
14. **NO PETS.**
15. **NO DRONES! If we catch you with a drone, you will be asked to leave and not return.**
16. **Spectator Overnight:** There is a fee per motorhome/camper etc., in addition to the spectator fee: \$50 per night. There are no facilities for electricity or water. You must be self-contained. Please register your motorhome/camper by downloading the form and sending it to us, or you can contact us at 281-303-1844 or [info@texasmile.net](mailto:info@texasmile.net). All participants and approved spectators spending the night at the track must have OVERNIGHT wristbands and window credential on display for their motorhome/ camper. If you do not display the proper overnight credentials, you will be asked to leave the facility immediately. Overnight credentials can be picked up at the Registration tent upon arrival.
17. **TRASH DISPOSAL:** There are lined trash barrels throughout the facility. Please dispose of your trash properly.
18. **SMOKING - FIRE HAZARD / TRASH PROBLEM:** Make sure your cigarette is fully extinguished before disposing of it. Do not throw on the ground or in the grass. Ask the people around, if it is okay to smoke in their pit area. WATCH for FUEL!
19. **Explosives, pyrotechnic devices of any kind, and campfires are strictly prohibited. Firearms and barbeque pits are strictly prohibited for the general public and spectators.**
20. **We reserve rights to change the instructions as we deem necessary.**
